Lindbergh tells of the various thoughts 1 passed through his mind as he 2 near Le Bourget Airfield at Paris, 3. He was not aware that there 4 anyone below to meet him. The 5 at Le Bourget had been sent 6 that his flight was taking place. 7 he was three hours ahead of 8 He was afraid that at this 9 there might not even be a 10 on the field to guide him. 11 was also worried about the fact 12 he had not taken time to 13 a visa before leaving the United 14 . Possibly French immigration officials might not 15 let him land. He did not 16 French. He thought that this fact 17 also cause him further difficulties.

Down 18 , however, thousands of French men and 19 had been waiting since early evening 20 his arrival. At three-thirty he had 21 reported over Ireland. Later he was 22 over the coast of England. Around nine 23 he was reported over Cherbourg. 24 ten-thirty, his arrival time, some 100,000 25 had crowded into Le Bourget Airfield 26 see the young hero. As Lindbergh 27 the field, he noticed that the 28 leading to the airport seemed blocked 29 automobiles. When he came in for 30 landing, he saw many people on 31 field. He landed at the far 32 of the landing strip, in the 33 free space available. When the first 34 ran up to welcome him, Lindbergh 35 his head over the side of 36 plane, smiled and said, "Well, I 37 it."

Dr. **Pinel**, 64 specialized in treating mental disorders examined 15 boy and announced that he was 16 idiot and would not likely be 17 by any kind of training.

Jean-Marc-Gaspard Itard, 18 young doctor. was convinced, however, that 19 boy **could** be helped. since he 20 that his low intelligence was caused 21 his solitary life in the woods 22 about the age of seven and 23 his ignorance of language. Itard took 24 boy and worked with him 25 five years. Victor, as Itard called him, 26 not learn to speak French, but 27 was able to understand a large 28 of written words and phrases. **He** 29 obey simple written commands and could 30 word cards to show his desires. 31 also acquired the manners and appearance 32 a civilized young man. Victor had 33 been helped by education, but Itard 34 concluded that Victor could not be 35 improved because his intelligence was subnormal.
